Winner of the Naumburg International Piano Competition and the Avery Fisher Career Grant, Mr. Pratt teaches at the Conservatory of Music at University of Cincinnati and is the Artistic Director of the World Piano Competition. He has been featured in Newsweek, People Magazine, and named one of the 50 Leaders of Tomorrow in Ebony Magazine's special 50th anniversary issue. Mr. Pratt has performed on the Today Show, Good Morning America and Sesame Street, been profiled on CBS Sunday Morning and was one of the featured soloists on PBS's "Live from the Kennedy Center". Mr. Pratt majored in piano, violin, and conducting at the

Mr. Chalifour began his tenure as Principal Concertmaster of the Los Angeles Philharmonic in 1995. The recipient of various grants and awards in his native Canada, he graduated with honors from the Montreal Conservatory at the age of 18 and then moved to Philadelphia to pursue studies at the Curtis Institute of Music.

Mr. Chalifour has appeared as soloist with conductors Pierre Boulez, Gustavo Dudamel, Charles Dutoit, Christoph Eschenbach, Sir Neville

Marriner, and Esa-Pekka Salonen. Outside the U.S., he has played solos with the Auckland Philharmonia, the Montreal Symphony, the Hong Kong Philharmonic, the National Orchestra of Taiwan, and the Malaysian Philharmonic, among others.

Trio FUGU consisting of pianist Ming Tsu, violinist Lorenz Gamma and cellist Joon Sung Jun perform and teach regularly at numerous festivals in the U.S., Mexico, China, Korea, Vietnam, Cambodia, Kazakhstan and many European countries such as Germany, France, Italy and Switzerland. They have recorded chamber music works for Cambria Records, Centaur Records, Cuneiform Records, EAR Records, ECM Records, Innova Recordings, Suisa and Tilia Records.

Aside from concertizing the three members of trio FUGU share an ardent dedication in educating avid young professional musicians, with their

activity as teachers of their individual instruments as well as of chamber music, both as private teachers and at already nearly a dozen colleges and universities combined, including schools such as the California Institute of the Arts, California State University Long Beach, UCLA and Indiana University Bloomington.
